Monitor student progress on Harmony Family Access. Parents are expected to engage in their student's learning activities by asking your student to show you their work on Canvas (3-12)/Clever (K-2). Communicate directly with teachers or administrators if there are any problems or concerns.

Communicate with your school office if there is a change or disruption with internet service or problem with equipment that prevents your student from completing their work. There will be designated areas outside each building where external WIFI is available

If your student does not turn in assignments, they will be counted as an unexcused absence (See building specific student handbook attendance policy).

In the event of eLearning/Remote day, students are expected to complete all work that day and submit by 11:59 pm the date the assignment is due.

The amount of expected student instructional and working time: maximum per subject daily by grade levels:

Grades K-2 10-15 minutes, Grades 3-5 20-30 minutes, Grades 6-12 30-45 minutes.

Students taking dual credit/AP courses may expect increased time and rigor based on course requirements.
